PROMOTION OF KCMUCo STAFF. From Associate Professor to Professor



PROF. JAFFU CHILONGOLA

Associate Professor in Biochemistry and Immunology, Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Faculty of Medicine: His last Promotion was in November 2019 to Associate Professor. From 2019 to June 2024, he had **26 publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Professor. He had **17.5 points** from publications (*9 Points as first or last author*) and **5.0 points** from teaching—a total of **22.5 points**, fulfilling the criteria required for Promotion to Professor. All 26 papers were assessed and recommended for Professorship promotion by two external reviewers. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee and the two reviewers and recommended them to CAC and the Senate and Council, which promoted him to **Professor**.



DR. KONDO CHILONGA

Senior Lecturer in the Department of Surgery, Faculty of Medicine: His last Promotion was in November 2019 to Senior Lecturer. From 2019 – June 2024, he had 46 publications in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Associate Professor. He has 21.9 points from publications (*12 Points as the first or last author*) and 5.0 points from teaching—a total of 26.9 points, fulfilling the Promotion to Associate Professor criteria. All 46 papers were confirmed for Associate Professorship promotion by one external reviewer and one internal reviewer. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee and the two reviewers and recommended to CAC and then to the Senate and Council, which Promoted him to **Associate Professor**.



DR. BALTHAZAR NYOMBI.

Senior Lecturer in the Department of Medical Laboratory Sciences, Faculty of Medicine: His last Promotion was in November 2017 to Senior Lecturer. From 2017 – June 2024, he had **15 publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Associate Professor. He has **8.3 points** from publications (*1.8 Points as the first or last author*) and **4.0 points** from teaching—a total of **12.3 points**, fulfilling the criteria for Promotion to Associate Professor. **All 15 papers** were recommended for Associate Professorship promotion by one external reviewer and one internal reviewer. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee, and of the two reviewers and recommended to CAC, and then to Senate and Council which Promoted him to **Associate Professor**.



DR. DAVID MSUYA

Senior Lecturer in the Department of Surgery, Faculty of Medicine:

His last Promotion was in November 2019 to Senior Lecturer. From 2019 – June 2024, he had **56 publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Associate Professor. He had **26.7 points** from publications (*10.6 Points as the first or last author*) and **5.0 points** from teaching—a total of **31.7 points**, fulfilling the criteria for Promotion to associate Professor. **All 56 papers** were recommended for Associate Professorship promotion by one external reviewer and one internal reviewer. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee and the two reviewers and recommended them to CAC and the Senate and Council, which promoted him to **Associate Professor**.

DR. MARY VINCENT MOSHA

Lecturer in the Department of Community Health, Institute of Public Health: Her first appointment as a Lecturer was in December 2011. From 2011 – June 2024, she had **sixteen (16) publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. She had **7.7 points** from publications and **4.0 points** from teaching—a total of **11.7 points**, fulfilling the criteria required for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. Two internal reviewers confirmed that all sixteen papers meet the standards required for Promotion from lecturer to Senior Lecturer Rank. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee and of the two reviewers and recommended to CAC, and then to Senate which Promoted her to **Senior Lecturer**.



DR. ORGENES JASPER MBWAMBO

Lecturer in the Department of Urology, Faculty of Medicine: His first appointment as a lecturer was in October 2019. From 2019 – June 2024, he had **41 publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. He has **11.15 points** from publications and **5.0 points** from teaching—a total of **16.15 points**, fulfilling the criteria required for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. Two internal reviewers confirmed that all 41 papers meet the standards necessary for Promotion from Lecturer to Senior Lecturer Rank. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee and the two reviewers and recommended to CAC and the Senate, which promoted him to **Senior Lecturer**.



DR. JAMES SAMWEL NGOCHO

Lecturer in the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics, Institute of Public Health: His first appointment as a Lecturer was in January 2021. From 2021 – June 2024, he had **twenty-one (21) publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. He had **9.6 points** from publications and **4.0 points** from teaching—a total of **13.6 points**, fulfilling the criteria required for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. Two internal reviewers confirmed that all twenty-one (21) papers meet the Promotion to Senior Lecturer rank standards. The College Review Committee reiterated the recommendations by the faculty Review Committee and of the two reviewers and recommended them to CAC and then to the Senate, which Promoted him to **Senior Lecturer**.

Lecturer in the Department of Physiotherapy, Faculty of Rehabilitation Medicine: His first appointment as a Lecturer was in January 2019. From 2019 – June 2024, he had **ten (10) publications** in peer-reviewed journals submitted for evaluation. The papers were discussed and evaluated at the department and faculty level committees and recommended for Promotion to Senior Lecturer. He has **8.4 points** from publications and **4.0 points** from teaching—a total of **12.4 points**, fulfilling the criteria required for Promotion to Senior Lecturer.
