Call for Applications for 2 PhD Fellowships

Introduction

Applications are invited for PhD fellowship in Nursing and Midwifery to be funded by Norwegian Programme for Capacity Development in Higher Education and Research for Development (NORHED II). The Project is a collaborative effort involving KCMUCo, Kamuzu College of Nursing (KCN) Malawi and University of Stavanger Norway.

The selected candidates will be enrolled at KCMUCo, one in academic year 2021/2022 and the second will be enrolled in academic year 2022/2023. The PhD candidates will be jointly supervised by supervisors from partner institutions and will take part of their training in Norway. The candidates will be offered a 3 – 4 years scholarship on competitive basis.

The main objective of this project is to develop capacity of KCMUCo staff in the Faculty of Nursing with a focus on simulation-based teaching to be able to offer quality and effective teaching and improve research and learning.

Requirements:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Master of Science in Midwifery
- A GPA of 3.5 or above in undergraduate degree
- A GPA of 4.0 or above in Master's degree
- Intense interest and proven experience in Midwifery
- A strong ambition to accomplish the research goals and to pursue a scientific career path
- Should not be registered for PhD in any institution
- Engagement in teaching is an added advantage
- Must be an employee of KCMUCo and ready to sign the bond.
- Must be a Tanzanian Citizen

The application must include:

- Application letter
- A Motivation Letter
- A 2 -3 page of research Concept Note within the focus areas, explaining the proposed research question(s) and planned methodologies.
- Certified copies of certificates and academic transcripts
- List of peer reviewed publications (if any)
- Recent CV indicating position and employer
- Two letters of recommendations from academicians with their telephone numbers and e-mail addresses
- Confirmation of study leave from your employer
